At the age of 12, she left the comfort of her homeland to pursue educational opportunities in the United States. Little did she know, her exodus was divinely orchestrated to best prepare her for a life of service.

In 2015, Pascale graduated from the University of Florida (UF) Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Science in Health Education. Two years later, her passion for health and commitment to healthcare equity led her to acquire a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from UF's College of Nursing. Despite the overwhelming challenges of completing these rigorous degrees at one of the Top 5 public universities in America, Pascale always reminded herself of her "why." At her core, she believes that quality healthcare is a fundamental human right that every person deserves.

Pascale was one of the inaugural members of P4H Global (Projects for Haiti Global), a nonprofit dedicated to eradicating poverty in Haiti through education. From 2012 to 2020, she served as the Communications and Publicity Director. Throughout those years, Pascale led over 400 students to Haiti on Spring Break trips. Pascale was instrumental in recruiting and training these students for their week of service. Throughout these years, she organized the Health Education workshops, which served over 1,000 Haitians in Cap-Haitien. Today, Pascale proudly serves as the youngest member of P4H Global's Board of Directors.

In August 2021, Pascale represented Haiti at the Miss Supranational Beauty Pageant in Poland. She became the first Haitian woman to be a semi-finalist at the renowned competition. Pascale garnered international love and acclamation as she was also crowned Miss Supranational Caribbean 2021— bringing home Haiti's first crown ever. More notably, Pascale represented Haiti at the 70th Miss Universe Competition in Israel. As Miss Universe Haiti 2021, her mission was and remains to empower women to fearlessly pursue their dreams despite obstacles they may face. Pascale deeply believes that circumstances do not determine one's potential. When she is not representing Haiti on a pageant stage, she continues to champion access to quality education through P4H Global and works as a Registered Nurse.

Pascale utilizes her influence and platform to advocate and contribute to her community in the United States and Haiti. She serves as a Health Education Consultant for large organizations such as Hope for Haiti and is a global ambassador for MamaBaby Haiti. Pascale is well sought after host and speaker.
